During the Fulton County Fair in Lewistown, IL  
Friday, July 27, 2018 – 10:00 a.m.  
Organized by Fulton County 4-H Horse Committee



**This show is open only to Fulton County 4-H members, or FFA members in a Fulton County school.** All horses and ponies must arrive by 9:30 a.m. Entries will be made that morning – Entries for classes 1-5 must be made by 9:45 a.m. All other classes must be entered by 10:30 a.m. Cost to enter is \$2.00 per class, or \$10.00 for all day, or \$25.00 for a family of 3 or more all day. Cash prizes will be given in each class – **the amounts will depend on the donations we receive from the local businesses**, but in recent years they have been \$10, \$9, \$8, \$7, \$6, \$5, \$4, \$3, ... Spectators should bring lawn chairs. Any dogs must be tied to trailer or vehicle, cannot run loose at any time.

***Coggins papers will be checked. Helmets required whenever mounted at the event.***

A horse or pony can only show in one halter class.

2. Pony Halter, under 52"
3. Pony Halter, 52" but under 56"
4. Western Halter
5. English Halter
6. Showmanship, Junior (Ages 8-13 as of 9/1/17)
7. Showmanship, Senior (Ages 14-18 as of 9/1/17)
8. Walk-Trot (first or second year Horse member – if you are in this class, you cannot lope/canter in any other class; cannot be in classes 9, 10, or 11)
9. English Pleasure (Cannot be in class 8)
10. Pony Pleasure (Cannot be in class 8)
11. Western Pleasure Horse (Cannot be in class 8)
12. Fun Class – Egg and Spoon
13. Pony Barrels
14. Horse Barrels
15. Flag Race or Plug Race
16. Pony Pole Bending
17. Horse Pole Bending
18. Fun Class – Other
